Special Notices:

Since this area is prone to ticks and chiggers, it is highly recommended that each cadet bring a Deet based insect repellent such as Cutter or Repel. Also insure that each cadet checks themselves thoroughly for ticks Sunday when they return home. Ticks can be very small and like to attach themselves in hard to check places such as along the crease of the legs or along the edges of underwear. The health hazard of ticks is generally reported as minimal when the ticks are removed within 24-48 hours. Chiggers are tiny mites that normally come off with the first exposure to soap & water. Chiggers are not generally a health hazard, but cause severe itching.

1. Need Adult volunteers to help with transportation, please contact jeff@batson.biz and let him know if you can help, the unit will pay for gasoline to and from Tennessee.
2. This is a weather-permitting drill. If it looks like rain in Tennessee we may have a short notice cancellation and reschedule.
3. Sleeping bags, and pillows required.
4. Bring \$20 to help defray the cost of food, targets, safety gear, ammunition, etc.
5. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected at first Muster.
6. Office Hours are 1800-2000 every Wednesday. This is a change from the bi-weekly schedule. Contact the CO to let him know that you are coming to his place of business. You can discuss issues, look for uniform items, and take examinations during this time, but you need to let him know that you are coming to ensure he or his representative will be there. This is also the optimum time to contact the adult staff by telephone.
7. Please upload drill photos to the Yahoo group (USNSCC2745).
8. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a chronometer is encouraged.
9. **Directions** to Hanger 5 – Hanger 5 is the first building as you enter the “Navy” side of the base from Dobbins ARB. Enter the Dobbins Main Gate. (Do not enter the Navy gate; we have not made security arrangements with this gate). Continue straight until you begin to see the airfield. Bear left at the fork. You can see Hanger 5 on your left. It has a distinctive “Naval Air Station Atlanta” marking.
10. If your ID Card has expired or if it will expire prior to Aug. 09, you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$75.00 for re-enrollment. This ensures that you have a current ID Card.
11. **Contact your Squad Leader or PO1 Schwartz to confirm your attendance TODAY. If you are a squad leader or assistant squad lead leader and will not be able to attend, you still must contact your squad. If you do have the appropriate telephone numbers, email jeff@batson.biz and it will be provided offline (we cannot publish cadets’ telephone numbers in this POD).**
12. There is no formal parents meeting this drill.

Standing Orders

1. The appropriate civilian attire for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
2. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
3. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
4. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
5. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Executive Officer.
6. Cadets are reminded that 75% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 coursework per year is mandatory in the 2745th Seabee Battalion.
