Special Notices:

1. Need Adult volunteers to help with transportation to and from Corp of Engineers to Coast Guard Aux, and from Coast Guard Aux to Camp Site and back, please contact jeff@batson.biz or Brian@helpwriteinc.com and let us know if you can help.
2. Need to bring sleeping bag, pillow, tent if you have one and life preserver if you have one. Also need to have PT and swim gear (Shorts, T-shirt and swimming trunks and towel). Additionally, if you are going to board a boat you must have boat shoes or sneakers.
3. Bring \$7 per Cadet to help with meal costs.
4. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected at first Muster on Saturday at Army Corps of Engineers-Lanier Project Management Office, 1050 Buford Dam Road, Buford, GA 30518.
5. The campground is Bolding Mill campground 4055 Chestatee Road, Gainesville GA 50506.
6. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a chronometer is encouraged.
7. Boating will be at Gainesville Dock on Sunday.
8. If your ID Card has expired or if it will expire prior to Aug. 2010, you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$75.00 for re-enrollment. This ensures that you have a current ID Card.

Standing Orders

1. The appropriate civilian attire for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
2. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
3. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
4. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
5. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Commanding Officer.
6. Cadets are reminded that 75% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 course per year is mandatory in the 2745th Seabee Battalion.
