### Special Notices:

1. Bring \$5 to help defray the cost of food this weekend.
2. Bring your shoe polishing kit and your dress shoes and your complete Dress Blues uniform, including ribbons/medals.
3. The Ships Bell Chronometer will not be available this drill.
4. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected at first Muster.
5. This drill is overnight and we hope to have all drills be overnight from now on. We have obtained 30 cots, and for this drill each cadet should bring a sleeping bag or equivalent (lots of blankets), pillow, suitable and appropriate sleepwear, and toiletries.
6. Cadets are reminded to bring all items for the weekend on Saturday as they will not be going home Saturday night.
7. Office Hours are 1800-2000 every Wednesday. This is a change from the bi-weekly schedule. Contact the CO to let him know that you are coming to his place of business. You can discuss issues, look for uniform items, and take examinations during this time, but you need to let him know that you are coming

to ensure he or his representative will be there. This is also the optimum time to contact the adult staff by telephone.

8. **Parents – we need your help!** We have made arrangements to buy a bus, but until the staff has completed licensing and insurance is arranged, we desperately need help with transportation. This weekend we will travel twice to and from locations in the metro area. Please volunteer your time, especially if you have a vehicle with many seat belts. It would also be most helpful if you could confirm to [brian@helpwrite.com](mailto:brian@helpwrite.com) . We will paint our bus. 9. The Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) camouflage woodland B uniform will be worn at this weekend. The dress blue uniform will be worn while on watch and for inspection on Sunday. The alternative (discouraged) is the dungaree uniform.
10. Physical Readiness Test will be Sunday morning. Physical Fitness (PT) gear: Running Shoes, white socks, shorts, white t-shirt or any USNSCC T-shirt, ballcap
11. Please upload drill photos to the Yahoo group (USNSCC2745).
12. Please note the early pickup / secure time on Sunday.
13. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a chronometer is encouraged.
14. We will be participating in the Chik-fil-A Bowl parade, but do not have further information at this time except that the uniform is Dress Blue or Salt & Pepper for NLCC.
15. **Directions** to Hanger 5 – Hanger 5 is the first building as you enter the “Navy” side of the base from Dobbins ARB. Enter the Dobbins Main Gate. (Do not enter the Navy gate; we have not made security arrangements with this gate). Continue straight until you begin to see the airfield. Bear left at the fork. You can see Hanger 5 on your left. It has a distinctive “Naval Air Station Atlanta” marking. Take a left when the road ends. Hanger 5 is just ahead now on your right.
16. If your ID Card has expired or if it will expire prior to JAN 09, you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$75.00 for re-enrollment. This will ensure that you have a current ID Card.
17. **Contact your Squad Leader or PO1 Schwartz to confirm your attendance TODAY. If you are a squad leader or assistant squad lead leader and will not be able to attend, you still must contact your squad. If you do have the appropriate telephone numbers, email [jeff@batson.biz](mailto:jeff@batson.biz) and it will be provided offline (we cannot publish cadets’ telephone numbers in this POD).**
18. There is no formal parents meeting this drill.
19. There is a new regulation that you must be an E2 to attend ANY summer training except recruit training. Therefore, to be advanced to E2 you must 1) be enrolled for 3 months, 2) complete recruit training including passing the Physical Requirements Test at recruit training, 3) Complete the coursework Basic Military Requirements (BMR). You will not be allowed to attend an advanced training if you are not an E2 by the time that training begins, but you need to sign up for the advanced training now. Information about Winter Recruit Training can be found at the Sea Cadet Compass website. There is a training available in Georgia for the first time in many years.

20. There is a new regulation for promotion to Petty Officer 2<sup>nd</sup> Class and Chief Petty Officer. A cadet must have graduated Leadership Academy (POLA) to be promoted to PO2, and must have served on the cadet staff of a Recruit Training to be eligible to be promoted to CPO.

## Standing Orders

1. The appropriate civilian attire for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
2. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
3. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
4. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
5. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Executive Officer.
6. Cadets are reminded that 75% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 coursework per year is mandatory in the 2745<sup>th</sup> Seabee Battalion.
