Special Notices:

1. You must arrive by 0700 Saturday or the gate will be secured.
2. Don't forget to bring PT gear.
3. Required Coursework and Service Records will be collected at first Muster.
4. This drill is overnight and we hope to have all drills be overnight from now on. We are in the process of obtaining cots, but for this drill each cadet should bring a sleeping bag or equivalent (lots of blankets), something soft to put under the sleeping bag, pillow, suitable and appropriate sleepwear, and toiletries. If you have an inflatable mattress or cot, you may bring these items as well.
5. Cadets are reminded to bring all items for the weekend on Saturday as they will not be going home Saturday night.
6. Office Hours are 1800-2000 every other Wednesday. Contact the CO to let him know that you are coming to his place of business. You can discuss issues, look for uniform items, and take examinations during this time, but you need to let him know that you are coming to ensure he or his representative will be there.
7. This drill will consist almost entirely of the Dobbins Air Show featuring the world famous Thunderbirds. A crowd over 100,000 is expected. Cadets should plan to bring money for lunch both days to use at one of the many food booths (or bring

- and carry your own sack lunch). Saturday dinner and Sunday morning breakfast will be served at Hanger 5. Cadets 16 years and older will be expected to work our assigned fundraising food booth. Shorts, t-shirt, and ball cap are appropriate attire for this work.
8. **Parents – we need your help!** This is our big fundraising weekend and the Air Show does not come along every year. We can expect to make over \$1000 during the weekend, but we need to man the food booth with at least 12 adults throughout the weekend.
 9. Cadets under the age of 16, when not on watch, will be assigned to a Navy League recruiting booth with other non-2745th Battalion sea cadets. These same younger cadets will have ample free time to observe the Air Show and see some of the exhibits. You may wish to bring extra money for souvenirs and food.
 10. 3 older cadets, but not yet 16 years old, will be assigned to work with the vendors transporting ice.
 11. The Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) camouflage woodland B uniform will NOT be worn at all this weekend. Its wear is prohibited by USNSCC regulations in a public setting such as the air show.
 12. You may not be able to get on the base with your vehicle through our normal means after 0700 on Saturday.
 13. Physical Readiness Test will be Saturday. Muster in Physical Fitness (PT) gear Saturday. (Running Shoes, white socks, shorts, white t-shirt or any USNSCC T-shirt, ballcap)
 14. Please upload drill photos to the Yahoo group.
 15. Please note the late pickup / secure time on Sunday. We recommend that parents, if not already working in the food booth, come early and enjoy the airshow. It may be very difficult to get on base Sunday evening at 100,000 air show attendees exit the premises.
 16. All hands need to bring a copy of this POD to drill. Also, a watch is encouraged.
 17. If your ID Card has expired or if it will expire prior to DEC 08, you will need to bring a check in the amount of \$75.00 for re-enrollment. This will ensure that you have a current ID Card.
 18. **Contact your Squad Leader or PO1 Schwartz to confirm your attendance TODAY. If you are a squad leader or assistant squad lead leader and will not be able to attend, you still must contact your squad. If you do have the appropriate telephone numbers, email jeff@batson.biz and it will be provided offline (we cannot publish cadets' telephone numbers in this POD).**
 19. There is no formal parents meeting this drill.
 20. There is a new regulation that you must be an E2 to attend ANY summer training except recruit training. Therefore, to be advanced to E2 you must 1) be enrolled for 3 months, 2) complete recruit training including passing the Physical Requirements Test at recruit training, 3) Complete the coursework Basic Military Requirements (BMR). You will not be allowed to attend an advanced training if you are not an E2 by the time that training begins, but you need to sign up for the advanced training now. Information about Winter Recruit Training can be found at the Sea Cadet Compass website. There is a training available in Georgia for the first time in many years.

21. There is a new regulation for promotion to Petty Officer 2nd Class and Chief Petty Officer. A cadet must have graduated Leadership Academy (POLA) to be promoted to PO2, and must have served on the cadet staff of a Recruit Training to be eligible to be promoted to CPO.

Standing Orders

1. The appropriate civilian attire for cadets who have not received uniforms is plain dark dress shoes or boots, dark socks, dark blue “dickie” style trousers, belt, plain collared shirt or USNSCC T-shirt, and unit ball cap. No part of the sea cadet uniform will be worn until all parts can be worn appropriately.
2. The USNSCC ID must be on your person at all times while on station or in uniform or during any drill period including travel.
3. No personal gear shall be unattended unless secured in authorized storage as required for station security requirements.
4. Cadets may not operate motor vehicles with other non-family cadets while on station.
5. No cadet may leave drill for any reason, including with adult supervision, without permission of the Command Duty Officer or the Executive Officer.
6. Cadets are reminded that 75% drill attendance is mandatory in the US Naval Sea Cadet Corps. At least 1 summer training, and completion of 1 coursework per year is mandatory in the 2745th Seabee Battalion.
