Subj: RECRUIT TRAINING INSTRUCTION (RTI)

1. Recruit Training Instruction (RTI) is the first and required training required of all Cadets of the United States Naval Sea Cadets Corps (USNSCC). Information about the USNSCC may be found www.seacadets.org .
2. RTI is sometimes termed “Boot Camp”, and the scope of the training is typical of other recruit trainings of the military services.
3. Cadets may not advance in rank until successful completion of this training.
4. The training is offered at different times during the year, but primarily during the summer months. The typical duration is 2 weeks, but shorter, more intense courses are occasionally available.
5. Upon successful graduation, a cadet is fully ready for all other challenges and responsibilities in the USNSCC. It is often the hardest and most significant achievement to date in a young person’s life.
6. Physical and mental fitness training is accomplished throughout the training.
7. The academic portion is also rigorous. Topics typically include:
 - i. Standards of Conduct
 - ii. Naval History
 - iii. Chain of Command
 - iv. Professionalism
 - v. Watchstanding
 - vi. Core Values
 - vii. Military Courtesies
 - viii. Enlisted Rate & Officer Rank
 - ix. Shipboard Communications
 - x. Basic Seamanship
 - xi. First Aid
 - xii. US Navy Aircraft and their Missions
 - xiii. Damage Control & Firefighting
 - xiv. Fire Extinguishing
 - xv. Survival at Sea
 - xvi. Navy Drug & Alcohol Policies
 - xvii. Sexual Harassment & Fraternalization
 - xviii. Grooming
 - xix. Discrimination
